APRIL 2012: From death to life. "Beloved, now we are the children of God; and it has not been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him. We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the brethren. He who does not his brother abides in death." (1John 3:2,3&14)

Everyone deals with the issues of life and death. It is natural for humans to think about the grave and what comes after. All ancient civilizations had their false gods and ideas of how to appease these angry gods. The thought of eternity was always in their minds and what they had to do in order to get to a better place.

Although systems like Hinduism do not believe in heaven or hell, they do believe in the false notion of reincarnation. 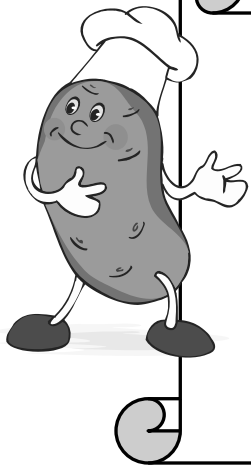
