JUNE 2010: OUR GREAT GOD: OUR FATHER GOD (Westminster Confession of Faith, chapter XII) "But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons. And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying 'Abba, Father!' Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ Jesus." (Galatians 4:4-7)

In the fullness of His own planning, God the Father sent, God the Son to do and accomplish something which no other person, power or realm could even come close to doing. There has always been in God's nature that of making perfect plans and then carrying them out perfectly. However, He works on His time schedule not ours. He is never early nor is our God ever late. We do not always understand the 'why' of His planning and we are not expected to do so. We are to trust the Lord that He always has our best interest in His sovereign heart.

Before Jesus came into the world, all of the human races were as aliens, a shipwrecked race with no hope of enjoying a close, personal relationship with the God of the universe. We all were groping around trying this, trying that, trying to find a lasting peace, trying to find meaning to life, but, coming up with emptiness and loneliness. The Bible tells us that all our efforts will only bring frustration and separation from God, not the longed for peace of mind and heart.

"Jesus has redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us. (Gal.3:13) Because of His death on the cross, His bodily resurrection and His ascension, Jesus makes it possible for those He has redeemed to become His actual sons and daughters. We who were formally children of Satan, are now included in the household of God by the completed work of our blessed Jesus. The almighty is now our heavenly Father. God the Father graciously has given us the right to call Him, 'Abba, Father' and has guaranteed us all the rights and privileges associated with His holy name.

Again, how much does God the Father love His own? His love is deeper than any ocean, higher than any mountain and able to span the greatest expanse of any chasm.

Fathers, men of this body of Christ, I challenge each of us to make sure our salvation so we will be able to stand in the gap against the powers of the enemy of our souls. Stay the course He has set before us. Trust in His love, His mercy, His grace and power to make us all we need to be!
