MAY 2010: "For this child I prayed, and the Lord has granted me my petition which I asked of Him. Therefore I also have lent him to the Lord; as long as he lives he shall be lent to the Lord. So they worshiped the Lord there." (1 Samuel 1:27&28)

For any society the importance of the family unit must never be minimized nor trivialized or that particular society will be on a downward spiral of self-destruction. God's word time and time again emphasizes this fact. In a society where anything related to God, His word or Christianity in general is being cut out of that society, the need for godly women stepping up to plate, praying for and their personal involvement in the lives whom God has entrusted them with must be a priority action item.

Every year Hannah and her husband would go to Shiloh to worship God and offer sacrifices. Each year Hannah prayed for the Lord to give her a son. Hannah then prayed to the Lord for the blessing of a son and even going so far as making a Nazirite vow for her yet unrealized son. That; "no razor would ever come upon his head." (1 Sam. 1:11b) At the right time God answered Hannah's prayer and she bore a son, called his name Samuel which meant; "Because I have asked for him from the Lord". (1 Sam. 1:20c)

I find it an amazing thing to consider the one thing which Hannah had prayed for so many years, a son, was given to the service of the Lord in the Temple in Shiloh at a tender young age. Samuel was given to Lord's work, not for a few years, but his whole life. I had to ask the question of myself as a believer; "Would I have done the same thing? It is one thing to dedicate a child to the Lord and another to do what Hannah and her husband did. The truth is we do need to give our children to the Lord and His work.

If you look through the Bible, the faith, hope and prayers of godly women helped influence kings, priests and disciples to great service for the Kingdom of God. Maybe you have experienced this influence in your own life. I just know in my heart that the answered prayers of those women in my life God has used to bring me to where I am today.

You do not always have to let a person know that you are praying for them, but I can tell you it sure is encouraging when someone comes to me and simply lets me know of their prayers. Prayer is a simple yet profound ministry in the body of Christ.

I want to challenge the women of our church to make it a point to pray fervently for, not only the children in your own family, but also for those who may come our way on Wednesdays and other times. Remember that statement; "the one who rocks the cradle will rule the world." Your godly influence can and will make a difference in the lives of our struggling youth. Who knows how God will turn that young life around and prepare that young man or woman for the work of His service? Do consider this challenge and make it a priority item in your daily routine.
