OCTOBER 2011: God's Building Process. "You also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Christ Jesus...But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that we may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light." (1 Peter 2:5&9)

As I contemplate these words from the Apostle Peter, I think to myself; "But I am so sinful. There too many times I feel that I am a million miles from where I should be. My faith is so weak and I am so completely unworthy. I don't feel so holy, like a royal priest or very special." Do you ever struggle with these thoughts? I believe we all struggle with these thoughts from one degree to another. We may even feel lower than a snake's belly.

However, does our God stop loving us, stop working in us or caring for us as we experience all or some of the above? If we have one thing which gives us hope, it is at these very moments when our Lord is holding and keeping us. He will never lose His grip on us, His children.

The other matter to consider is, if I felt worthy of being called a royal priest, a part of His holy nation or as one of His special people, something would be unbelievably wrong with this equation. It is precisely when we feel unworthy that our Lord says; "I have made you worthy. I have declared this by My holy name!" Question 33 of the Shorter Catechism reminds us; "What is justification? Justification is an act of God's free grace, wherein He pardons all our sins, and accepts us as righteous in His sight, only for the righteousness of Christ imputed to us, and received by faith alone." This is precisely the point. We don't, nor can anyone get to the place by his or her own power or righteousness whereby God will declare that person righteous. There is only One worthy, One capable of taking sin out of the way. The One is Jesus, the spotless Lamb of God.

Also remember that we are not justified simply for the sake of being justified. Our Lord has a purpose for each of us, both toward those in the church and those outside. It is vitally important to realize God has justified us by the blood of the Lamb, that we are brought together and bound together by the power of the Holy Spirit as the body of Christ for service.

All of the things which the Apostle Peter mentions, God declares that this is exactly who and what His people are in Christ Jesus. We are His glorious body here on earth. As sons and daughters we now have direct access to Him. There is no need for us to go through an earthly priest for prayer or confession. The Bible declares that Jesus is our Great High Priest and we are His royal priesthood. Jesus calls us a holy nation, a royal priesthood so we can minister to others and declare by the authority of God's Word, there is One Who gave everything and intercedes for His own even now.

Isn't it wonderful that we are allowed to be a part of our Lord's working as His glorious body. As I hope we all understand that with this comes the great responsibility of interceding and ministering to others, and for all sorts of situations which may arise. But, as General Stonewall Jackson always reminded his wife as he asked her to pray for an end of the War Between the States; "My dear wife, always remember to end your petition with; 'Not my will but Yours be done". So we too, do not come demanding of God, but humbly pleading for His will to be accomplished.

Remember how God views us. As a believer each of us are a part of His "special people". Praise God for this glorious truth! Yours in Christ, Meredith.

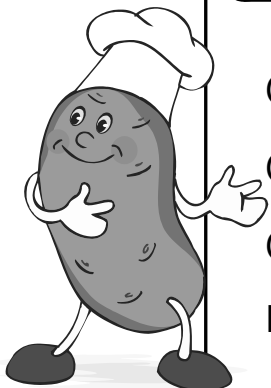
